## ***THE SHELTER OF GOD'S PEACE***

**Psalm Psalm 46:1-11** "I could have some peace in my life if it weren't for . . ." We could all complete that statement with something that, at best, is an irritant or, at worst, causes great turmoil in our lives. Peace is not the absence of irritating or turbulent problems, but we can experience confidence and assurance in the midst of turmoil. The question is: where do we find peace in the midst of turmoil? What security do we have when the very ground under our feet shifts and heaves like the waves of the ocean? According to Psalm 46, the only place where we can find true peace is in God, Himself!

Based on the inscription over Psalm 46, it is a choir anthem for congregational worship. Martin Luther's majestic hymn "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God" was inspired by this psalm. The kingdom of God is like a mighty fortress against which the waters, which often in Psalms represent chaos and death, have no power (46:1-3). The psalm looks forward to the eternal reign of God in the new earth (46:8-9), but celebrates the present reign of God in this troubled world (46:4-6). The psalm both celebrates God's great ability in all situations and identifies why His people can experience peace and security in times of trouble.

**2 Tim 2:15** Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.

Paul wrote 1 Timothy to one of his closest disciples; Timothy who was pastor at Ephesus. One of the reasons why Paul wrote this letter was to instruct Timothy in how to deal with numerous issues that had come up in the church at Ephesus. Paul wrote to instruct how the gospel confronts the Believer's everyday life. In particular Paul addresses the false teaching that had arisen in Ephesus and how the gospel applies to this false teaching and how the gospel applies to the church's structure. 1 Timothy calls the church at Ephesus (and us today) to live out the implications of the gospel in our everyday life and in our church. Paul's letter written to the young pastor Timothy will help us at FBC Oakhurst see what God's vision is for His church. Our time in 1 Timothy will help us see what God has called His church to do and look like. We must constantly be examining ourselves and our church to see if we live in accordance with what God has laid out for us in Scripture.
